The Sowers Club of Nebraska Foundation awards a limited number of scholarships annually to deserving High School applicants. Individuals must meet the following qualifications to be considered:

1. Must be a US citizen and Nebraska resident.
2. Must be a High School Senior.
3. Must attend a university, college, junior college or trade school in Nebraska this Fall.
4. Must submit a complete application form, including three letters of recommendation, by March.
5. Must be willing to attend our Disbursement Function in December for dinner (with a guest if desired) at a Country Club location.

The Application form will provide the Sowers Club of Nebraska Foundation with the information needed to appropriately consider and select the recipients. Considerable latitude is given to applicants to arrange and present their information, but it must be complete, neat and completely accurate. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from further consideration. The information submitted will be confidentially reviewed by a Committee of Sowers Foundation members using a pre-determined system of ratings. Winners will be selected based upon their combined scores and notified once a decision is made. If selected, the scholarship award will be transferred in your name to the educational institution of your choice to help pay for tuition, room, meals and/or board.

Sections / Page Headers

Section A: High School Grade Transcript.

Section B: High School Activities -- Sports, Clubs, Music, Theater, Special Events, years of participation, awards, positions of leadership, etc.

Section C: Community Service Activities – Activities, FFA, Scouts, Church, years of participation, awards received, time spent, etc.

Section D: Work Experience – Companies, family businesses, dates of employment, hours worked, contact info, etc.

Section E: Financial Need – Description of your financial situation including estimated costs of your education, scholarships already received w/ amounts, plans for paying for school, parental help available, how COVID-19 might have affected you and/or your family, plans for outside employment while going to school, etc.

Section F: Personal Statement / Career Plan – What do you plan to do with your education? Do you have plans to pursue an advanced degree? Where will you settle?

Section G: Intangibles / Special Information (Optional) – Describe any special circumstances or personal challenges you'd like to share.

Section H: Three letters of recommendation from past instructors, employers, close family friends, etc.
